All-League Selection Criteria

1. The following procedures must be incorporated into individual sport rules as it pertains to All-League selections.
 - a. These procedures must be reviewed during the sport specific end of season meetings during the 2007-2008 school year to take effect for the 2008-2009 school year.
- Sports that have a League Championship Tournament will honor the 1st team All-Stars sometime during the Championship Playoffs.
- Sports that have a League Championship Tournament will announce 2nd Team and Honorable Mention All-Stars sometime during the Championship Playoffs.
- All Star selections, for team sports, are to be based on Regular Season games only.
- Football (Team Sport) and Cheerleading (Team Sport) shall remain status quo.
- Collection of information, for team sports, is to occur prior to the start of the Colonial League Playoffs of the respective sport.
- The All-Star selection criteria / positions are to be left up to the League Coaches and discussed at the end of the season meeting each year.
- Sports that must be identical in process for selecting all-stars include: Boy's Tennis and Girl's Tennis, Boy's Soccer and Girl's Soccer, Fall Cheerleading and Winter Cheerleading, Boy's Basketball and Girl's Basketball.
- Each sport is to review their process for All-Star tiebreaker situations at their 2007-2008 post-season meeting, and make changes if deemed necessary.
- Full Criteria and rules for the All-Star selections will be listed in the Appendix of the League Constitution within each set of sport rules.

- All sport chairpersons will submit full All-Star lists to the media in the form of a press release and to the League Website Coordinator for publication. The document being sent to the League Website Coordinator MUST be created in Microsoft Word, Microsoft Excel, or Adobe Acrobat.
- To honor 2nd Team All-Stars, the Colonial League will provide a certificate template for individual schools to use as they see fit.
- Coaches may nominate their own player however CANNOT vote for their own player during the process.
- The coaches are permitted to fund and/or sponsor an MVP award on their own accord however this award will not be funded nor sanctioned by the Colonial League.
